

**MS/BLAIR, CHARLES A.**

Charles A. Blair, son of Governor Austin Blair, was born in 1854, spent most of his life as a resident of Jackson, Michigan. He was admitted to the bar in 1876, and practiced law there until elected attorney general of Michigan in 1903. Blair served until 1905, when he became a member of the Supreme Court, continuing in this office until his death in 1912.

The papers pertain chiefly to his professional career in the years from 1897-on. There is much material on his candidacy for the two offices noted above, and some material dealing with family and personal affairs.
